

My daughter has been doing Suzuki violin for two years now and the book is wonderful. I decided to try the guitar book as well but it doesn't really give the detail and help needed to begin guitar. I wish I had saved the money.

As a stand alone book this isn't much. However anyone who knows about the Suzuki Method, it is a superlative method when done right, knows that Suzuki is not a book, it is a philosophy and repertoire of songs. 1, you have a private lesson with a trained teacher; 2, you have a group class with others studying the same thing; 3 there is a community recital/performance component so you can hear others performing music from throughout the series in all stages; 4 you listen to the accompanying CD(s) at home. When done right it, it is fun and perfect. When misunderstood or

taught wrong it doesn't work. Find a Suzuki teacher to understand how this book works.
