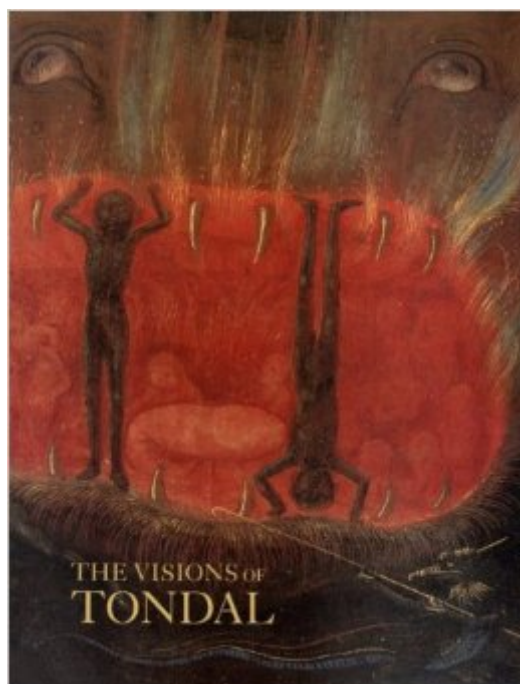


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The Visions Of Tondal: From The Library Of Margaret Of York
