

Not a comprehensive look at ethnomusicology whatsoever - this is more a sampling of essays from different locales and areas of expertise. That being said, all the chapters are well-written and it is a nice balance of different parts of the world. Additionally, the organizational system is nice; Post breaks the book down into sections based on mutual themes (Nationalism, Technology, etc) I took a summer graduate music course and this was the required text - we each had to do a conference-style presentation on one of the chapters (Mine was the one on Saami culture/joik in northern Europe). In this sense, I was able to observe a detailed breakdown of each chapter, and

that made the book ever more interesting. I'm not sure if I would read it for funsies, but if ethno is your thing, it's well-varied and interesting.

This was required reading for a graduate level course.
